## **Assembly Instructions:**









WHAT YOU'LL NEED: Scissors, Elmer's glue (or a glue stick), a ruler or other straight-edge, and a length of string. Optional: a scoring tool (see below) and a black marker for darkening the edges of the cut paper.

FOLDING TIP: It's helpful to 'score' the fold lines before folding. You can use an old ink pen, a knitting needle, the end of a paper clip, or any metal object that will crease the paper without tearing it. Scoring will help you fold much more quickly and precisely.

## ASSEMBLY:

Begin by cutting out the pendant (but DO NOT separate the two sides). Although each side can be cut out individually, it's a little faster if you cut out the outer rectangle, fold as precisely as possible along the center line (as shown in Figure 1), and then cut out the pendant. Note: the outer rectangle doesn't need to be cut very precisely but it IS important to fold as precisely as possible along the center line before cutting out the pendant.

After cutting out the pendant, place a length of string through the pendant's top loop, as shown in Figure 2. Now glue the two sides of the pendant (but not the top loop) together, as shown in Figure 3. Place the pendant around your neck and knot the string at the desired length, as shown in Figure 4.

Your new hand-crafted pendant is now ready to wear!
