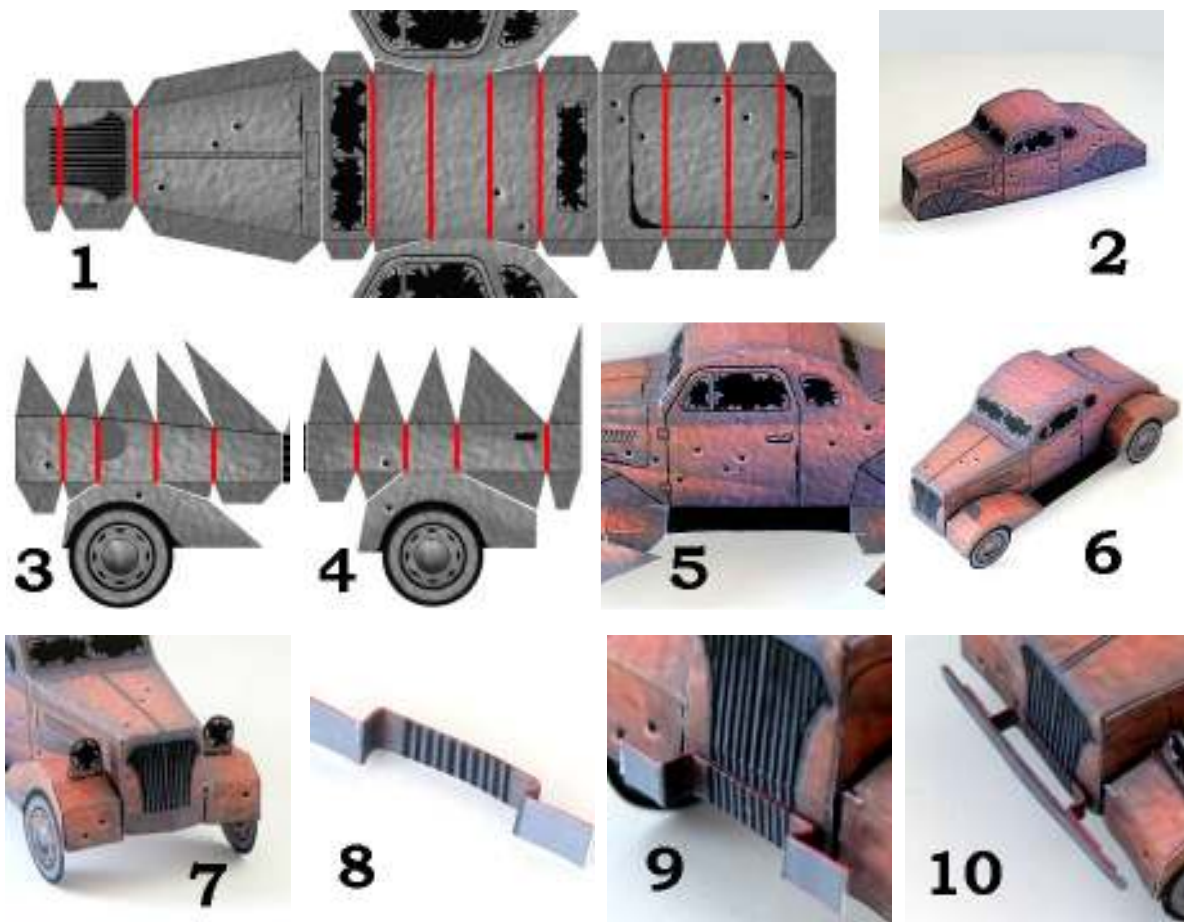


# THE HAUNTED CAR – ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS – Page 1.



## WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

Scissors, Elmer's glue (or a glue stick), and a ruler or other straightedge.  
A black marker is also handy, but is not required.

## MODEL ASSEMBLY:

Begin by cutting out the car body on Parts Page 1. Cut along the four white lines to separate the tabs from the side panels (but do not separate the side panels from the center panel). Fold both side panels **DOWNWARD**. The center panel has two blue lines, one below each window. Fold **UPWARD** along both of these lines. There are nine fold lines on the center panel that should be folded **DOWNWARD**. Since they're difficult to see, refer to Figure 1 for their location. After making all nine folds, fold all of the tabs **DOWNWARD**. Line up the edges of the center panel with the edges of the side panels and glue the tabs to the inside of the side panels to form the body of the car, as shown in Figure 2.

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Now cut out the LEFT FENDER PIECE on Parts Page 2. Cut along the four white lines to separate the tabs from the side panels (with the wheels). Fold the two side panels DOWNWARD and fold the gray tab UPWARDS. Fold UPWARDS along the blue lines on either side of the running boards (the dark center area).

Each fender has four fold lines that should be folded DOWNWARD. Figure 3 shows the front fender fold lines and Figure 4 shows the rear fender fold lines. After making these folds, fold all of the tabs DOWNWARD.

Place the gray tab between the front and rear wheel wells of the car body, as shown in Figure 5, and glue the tab to the inside of the car body. For both the front and rear fenders: line up the edges of the fender with the edges of the wheel well on the car body and glue the five tabs to the matching panels in the wheel well. Finish each fender by gluing the remaining four tabs to the inside of the fender's side panel. The fenders should now resemble Figure 6.

Cut out the RIGHT FENDER PIECE on Parts Page 2. This piece should be folded and assembled in the same manner as the LEFT FENDER PIECE. After finishing all four fenders, cut out the four INNER WHEELS on Parts Page 2. Glue an inner wheel to the inside of each of the car's four wheels. Trim as needed. If you wish, you can now use a black marker to darken the edges of the finished wheels.

Next cut out the HEADLIGHTS piece on Parts Page 1. Don't cut out the individual parts yet, just cut out the entire rectangle, cutting along the black outside lines. Fold the two sides DOWNWARD along the red center line and glue the two sides together. Now cut out the two headlights. Trim as needed. If you wish, a black marker can now be used to darken the edges of the headlights. With the broken glass facing upwards, fold DOWNWARDS along the black line on each headlight. Place the headlights over the dark areas on the top of the front fenders, as shown in Figure 7, and glue both headlights in place.

Now cut out the FRONT BUMPER BRACE piece on Parts Page 1, again cutting along the outer black lines. Fold DOWNWARDS along the red center line and glue the two sides together. Then cut out the brace and trim as needed. With the grill (the gray stripes) facing upwards, fold the two light gray tabs DOWNWARDS and then fold the two dark gray tabs UPWARDS. The brace should now resemble Figure 8. Place the brace on the front of the car and glue it to the blank area under the front grill, as shown in Figure 9.

Cut out the FRONT BUMPER piece on Parts Page 1, fold DOWNWARDS along the red center line and glue the two sides together. Cut out the bumper and trim as needed. Glue the two gray rectangles on the back of the FRONT BUMPER to the two light gray tabs on the FRONT BUMPER BRACE, as shown in Figure 10.

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Next cut out the REAR BUMPER BRACE piece on Parts Page 2, cutting along the outer black lines. Fold DOWNWARDS along the red center line and glue the two sides together. Then cut out the brace and trim as needed. Fold the two light gray tabs DOWNWARDS and then fold the two dark gray tabs UPWARDS. Place the brace on the back of the car, under the trunk lid, and glue it in place.

Cut out the REAR BUMPER piece on Parts Page 1, fold DOWNWARDS along the red center line and glue the two sides together. Cut out the bumper and trim as needed. Glue the two gray rectangles on the back of the REAR BUMPER to the two light gray tabs on the REAR BUMPER BRACE.

And that completes the construction of the Haunted Car model! However... there's something unusual about this car. It usually appears to be a rusty ruined hulk, but sometimes it seems to transform itself into a mint condition automobile. To build the 'mint condition' version, cut out the parts on Pages 3 and 4 and assemble them in the same way as we did the rusty version.

You're now the owner of a haunted car. It would be advisable to drive cautiously at all times, and try not to do anything that might upset the vehicle or make it angry. The car will, of course, choose the radio station as well as deciding whether or not to run, what speed it would like to travel, and may sometimes choose your destination for you. Have Fun!
