



HEADSTONE TIC-TAC-TOE Parts Page 1.









HEADSTONES

HEADSTONE TIC TAC TOE Assembly Instructions:



WHAT YOU'LL NEED: Scissors, glue, a needle, a pencil, and 10 toothpicks (these should be two and a half inches long).

ASSEMBLY:

Begin by cutting out the UPPER PANEL on Parts Page 1. Fold the four gray tabs DOWNWARD and then fold all four side panels DOWNWARD. Glue the gray tabs to the inside of the side panels as shown in Figure 1.

Now we'll carefully punch nine holes in the UPPER PANEL. Begin by piercing the nine white dots with a needle. Then push a toothpick through each hole to enlarge it a little. Now push a sharpened pencil just far enough into each hole to enlarge it further, but not enough to push the pencil completely through, as shown in Figure 2. (It helps to twist the pencil as you push.) We want the holes to be large enough to be very easy to locate later with the playing pieces.

Now cut out the LOWER PANEL on Parts Page 1. Fold the four side panels DOWNWARD. Now punch all nine holes in the LOWER PANEL in the same manner as we did the previous holes.

The LOWER PANEL fits under the UPPER PANEL as shown in Figure 3. Line up the LOWER PANEL sides with the bottom edges of the UPPER PANEL sides, as shown in Figure 4, and glue in place.

Turn the finished game board over. Place a toothpick in each hole to be sure it stands upright. Now we'll make playing pieces to finish the game...

Begin by cutting Parts Page 2 in half, cutting between the groups of dark and light headstones. For each set of headstones, fold DOWNWARD along the black center line and then cut out the five individual headstones (but don't separate the two sides of each headstone or remove the red areas).

To finish each headstone, place a toothpick in the center of the headstone, with the top of the toothpick at the fold, as shown in Figure 5. Glue the two sides of the headstone together around the toothpick as shown in Figure 6. Then cut away the red areas as shown in Figure 7.
