


VALENTINES CANDY BOX Assembly Instructions.



WHAT YOU'LL NEED: Scissors, glue (or a glue stick), a ruler. A black marker is optional for darkening any white edges on the paper.

FOLDING TIP: It's helpful to 'score' the fold lines before folding. You can use an old ink pen, a knitting needle, the end of a paper clip, or any metal object that will crease the paper without tearing it. (I use a pointy little tool from a manicure kit.) Scoring will help you fold much more quickly and precisely.

ASSEMBLY:

Cut out the BOX. Then cut out the BOX SIDES.

For both BOX SIDES: Fold the black panels DOWNWARD and glue them to the back of the white panels. Then fold the gray tabs UPWARD, fold the white tab UPWARD, and fold DOWNWARD between all five black side panels.

Place the panels onto the BOX as shown in Figure 1. Glue the gray tabs to the box, and then glue the white tabs to the adjacent side panels.

Cut out the BOX liner and glue it over the gray tabs, as shown in Figure 2.

Cut out the LID, LID LINER and LID SIDES. Assemble in the same manner as the box. You should now be able to place the lid onto the box.

Cut out the TOP and glue it to the top of the box as shown in Figure 3. Trim as needed.

Cut out the SPIKES. For each SPIKE: Fold the bottom tabs (with rivets) UPWARD, and then fold DOWNWARD between all five triangular panels. Glue the gray panel to the back of the opposite metal panel.

Glue a SPIKE over each of the gray squares on the sides of the LID, as shown in Figure 4. Also glue the END SPIKE to the bottom tip of the box as shown.

Fill the box with candy and present it to whoever you want to impress!
