
MONSTER SET SIX: MORE ZOMBIES! (Assembly Instructions)



You'll need: Glue and Scissors.

Begin by cutting out the body piece. Don't separate the four sections, just cut out the entire piece. Fold the Back panel and the Blank panel both downward along the black lines. Fold the small Top panel downward along the black line. Now smear some glue on the Blank panel and glue the Back panel directly over the Blank panel, allowing the Front panel to curve as shown in Figure 1A. Next glue the Top panel down over the back of the head as shown in Figure 1B. You should now have a hollow body with a flat back and a curved front.

Cut out the arm piece along the outer red lines (but don't separate the two panels). Fold downward along the black center line and glue the two panels together. Now cut away the white areas, being careful not to cut off the monster's fingers (or your own). Place the black area of the arm piece against the back of the body piece and glue in the proper position, as shown in Figure 2A. Gently curve (don't crease) the arms upwards and the wrists and fingers downward, as shown in Figure 2B.

Now cut out the Base piece. Fold the two half circles upward along the black lines. Then lay the Half circles flat and slide them together as shown in figure 3A. While holding the circles together, Flatten the two upright panels to form a tab, as shown in Figure 3B. Glue the two sides of the tab together. Next cut out the black square and place it face down. Position the circular part of the Base over the unprinted side of the black square and glue them together. Trim away the white area around the Base. To connect the Base to the Body, glue the back of the tab to the inside of the Body's back panel, as shown in Figure 3C.

And that completes the construction of your zombie! Please note: The zombie has been fed prior to printing, and should not require any fresh brains for at least a little while...
